Dear Mr. Jones,

I am being in contact with you as our State Senator and Mr. Kevin Joyce as our State Representative with the following concerns about the States Right of Way and Sight Line at 127th Street and 74th Avenue entrance to Ishnala in Palos Heights, Illinois.

As the new President of our Homeowners Association and as Chairperson for the maintenance of our Island entrances and the other three entrances without landscaping, I have managed to replace all entry signs but the one at the above noted location.

The disparity of information I receive from IDOT and the Palos Heights Building Commissioner is such that they insist that this particular sign is an obstruction to on coming traffic.

However there are three huge trees that probably have grown from seeds of other nearby trees that sit in and on the easement and part of that home sight.----We have been told it is the State's responsibility to remove or at least cut them down to ground level.---- Repeated calls from the homeowners of that home (12704 74<sup>th</sup> Avenue) have resulted in no answer. We have been told it is in the realm of responsibility of the State Maintenance Department.

If these trees are removed we can then place the Ishnala sign parallel to 127<sup>th</sup> Street

Can you please intervene on our behalf and have the State finally own up to their duty.
